On Saturday June 4, Dutchess County Historical Society's 16th Annual Silver Ribbon House Tour visits the hamlet of Wappingers Falls and New Hamburg for an amazing look at the rich architectural heritage of an area that takes its name from the Wappingers Indians and German inhabitants. This was originally part of the Rombout patent. The Village of Wappingers Falls also holds claim to New York State's 6th oldest library, the Grinnell Library which will be part of our tour.

Some of the highlights will be

Obercreek , the home of the Reese family

Lahey barn: Sleighs and carriages from the 19th and 20th century

Several 18 and 19th Century private homes, one where iced tea will be served in the garden

The Mesier Homestead, parts of it dating to the 18th century and now a museum and home to the

Wappingers Historical Society
